

Terms & Conditions

We are encouraging people to book via our online system. This will be to reserve your slot as we are operating at a maximum capacity. You can select pay on arrival or you can pay online. If you visit the park without booking you will still be allowed to enter, if we are under this capacity.

Do we accept cash?:

We're not completely cashless! But please be ready to make on-site payments using a credit or debit card, rather than cash.

Refusing Entry

Trethorne Leisure reserves the right to refuse entry to the Park in the event that the capacity for visitors at the Park is reached and/or exceeded. Trethorne Leisure reserves the right, in its absolute discretion, to refuse admission to the Park, ban from entry into the Park, or remove from the Park without right to refund any person who;

A) Acts in an inappropriate and/or undesirable manner whilst traveling to the Park whether by bus, coach or other means. Where such behaviour has been reported to Trethorne Leisure Park.

B) Has behaved in, or in the vicinity of, the Park in a manner, which, in the opinion of Trethorne Leisure Park, has, or is likely to affect the safety and enjoyment of other guests or staff.

C) Uses threatening, abusive or insulting words or behaviour or in any way provokes or behaves in a manner which may provoke a breach of the peace.

General Information

Opening times of rides, attractions, cafes & kiosks may vary depending on business levels and/or weather conditions. The management reserve the right to change these without notice.

We are prepared to allow entry to the park to those visitors who are willing to comply with the Park regulations set out below. We are sure that you will wish to assist Trethorne Leisure Park in ensuring the Park and facilities remain a safe place in which to enjoy a fun and exciting experience. Whilst inside the Park all visitors must comply with any instructions given to them by Trethorne Leisure Park personnel.

1) All persons entering the Park must pay for admission or hold a valid admission ticket. If re-entry into the Park is required, you must obtain an appropriate hand stamp, before exiting the Park which must be shown at the time of re-entry to gain access to the Park.

2) Admission tickets are non-exchangeable, non-refundable and void if altered. Admission tickets will only be exchanged or refunded if Trethorne Leisure Park, in its absolute discretion, chooses to do so.

3) Children aged 16 years or older can enter the Park without an adult. Children under 16 years need to be accompanied by an adult aged 18 years or over. Any child or children whilst in the Park must remain under the control or supervision of an adult at all times

4) We regret that due to our zoo license conditions we no longer allow dogs on park (except guide dogs).

5) Any person found to be in the possession of an article deemed to be offensive or dangerous would be immediately escorted from the Park without the right to a refund and be open to prosecution.

6) The consumption of alcohol is permitted only in authorised places within the Park. Accordingly alcohol may not be taken into the Park.

7) Guests who appear to be under the influence of alcohol may be refused admission to the Park or escorted from the Park without right to refund.

8) The use of illegal substances is strictly prohibited and any persons found possessing, using or who appear to be under the influence of illegal substances will be refused admission or escorted from the Park without right to refund.

9) Trethorne Leisure Park will endeavour to ensure that as many rides and attractions as possible are available for use by guests. Trethorne Leisure Park reserves the right, without prior notice and without refund or compensation to close and/or change the programme of rides and attractions and/or the Park's operation hours. All rides, attractions, amusements, transport systems and other facilities must only be used in accordance with the operator's instructions.

10) Climbing or standing upon fences, barriers, walls, safety fences, rock arrangements, ride structures, exhibits or buildings is strictly prohibited. Trethorne Leisure Park reserves the right to prosecute any person found damaging or defacing any part of the grounds, fences, barriers, walls, ride structures, exhibits, fabrics or buildings and to initiate legal proceedings if appropriate.

11) No vehicles are permitted to remain in the Park outside the Park's normal operating hours.

12) From time to time Trethorne Leisure Park or other authorised parties carry out photography and/or video recording at the Park, which may feature visitors and staff.

If you have concerns over this then please contact a member of staff and we will ensure that your privacy is protected during your visit.

13) Trethorne Leisure Park takes no responsibility for any loss or damage to such belongings. Sensible clothing and footwear must be worn at all times when in and about the Park. Please note that for health and safety reasons shirts and shoes must be worn on all rides at all times.

14) Vehicles are parked at owner's risk. Trethorne Leisure Park takes no responsibility for damage caused to any vehicle using the car park. You park at your own risk; we do not guarantee the security of your vehicle and/or its contents.

15) By entering the Park you consent to us photographing or filming you and using the resulting pictures for any promotional purpose without payment to you. If you do not wish to be photographed or filmed, please contact Main Entrance Desk upon arrival they will be able to advise.

16) Height, age and weight restrictions apply to many of the attractions.

Special Offers

Special Offers are subject to our Terms & Conditions. All special offers are not to be used in conjunction with any other offer.

Online Tickets

Unfortunately Park tickets bought online are non-refundable or non-transferable.

Discount Vouchers

All Vouchers, including the are not to be used in conjunction with any other offer or our concession rate. These are only available for full paying tickets.

Smoking Policy

Trethorne Leisure Park has designated smoking areas whilst out in the fresh air. Smoking is not permitted in any other indoor spaces & including ride queue-lines. The policy above also applies to electronic cigarettes.

Season Passes

A valid **SEASON PASSES** admits the named person to Trethorne Leisure Park during normal opening hours and on normal opening days **Guaranteed for 200 days**. Season passes are not interchangeable or transferable for any reason and lost or stolen cards will be replaced at a cost of £5. The purchase of any Season Pass cannot be done so in conjunction with any other offer/voucher and cannot be purchased using the online discount. **Trethorne Leisure Park reserves the right to amend opening times, withdraw attractions, discounts and amend opening times without prior notice**. Some attractions are not included in the admission price, for which a reasonable charge is made. Trethorne Leisure Park season pass holders are subject to the same rules and regulations as all guests to the Park. The management reserve the right to refuse an application or renewal for a Trethorne Leisure Park Season Pass, or to withdraw a season pass. These terms and conditions are subject to change by the management without prior notice.

Season Pass cards must be presented on arrival at the park. Any card that has been forgotten or is lost or stolen must be replaced at a charge of £5.00. Admission will be refused to any person who does not have a valid Season Pass card.

You must be able to produce, when asked, a valid Season Pass card for each member. Lost membership cards will be replaced at a cost of £5 each

The terms of your membership to Trethorne Leisure Park also require you to have a 'recognisable photo' when scanning your Season Pass card at the park entrance. You will be asked to update this image if the entry team request so.

Please note a Trethorne Leisure Park Season Pass cannot be used for admission against Educational Trips.

Changing your Booking

- If, for any reason, you would like to amend your booking after it has been confirmed we will do our best to assist you.
- If you wish to amend your booking and provide us with more than 7 days' notice prior to arrival date then no charge will be made.
- If you wish to amend your booking and provide us with less than 7 days' notice then a cancellation charge will be added to your balance of £10.
- However, you may transfer your booking into someone else's name provided we are advised of, and are in agreement with, the changes, for which there is no administration fee payable.

Group Terms and Conditions

This confirmation is not your ticket for admission into Trethorne Leisure Park. A 20% deposit is to be made by cash or card only this will secure your booking. Once full payment is made to

Trethorne Leisure Park by cash or card only, you will receive the final confirmation by email. The confirmation must be presented at the ticket office to gain entry into the park.

The final balance payment for your group booking is due 14 days prior to arrival. If we do not receive your final balance payment at this time, your booking will be cancelled automatically and no refund given.

Limited opening times and some attractions and rides will operate during certain periods of the year. If, for any reason, you would like to amend your booking after it has been confirmed we will do our best to assist you. Admission prices are subject to change. If you wish to amend your booking and provide us with more than 7 days' notice prior to arrival date then no charge will be made.
